

The Fight to Preserve South Table Mountain Continuation

The above does not cover the South Table Mountain Park of 90 acres on the very eastern tip of South Table Mountain. About 15 to 20 acres only are on the top. Carl was attorney for Pleasant View Metro District 33 years. Ray Printz, first head of Jeffco Open Space, had a problem with Bunger who developed Applewood Mesa. Carl was friends with each and brokered the purchase. It went into the Pleasant View District by his efforts and is now Open Space in the late 60's or early 70's. As stated, as Pleasant View council with Ed Perlmutter, Carl worked out the east 40% of South Table Mountain when he found out the Colorado National Guard was leaving Camp George West. Working with many government agencies contracts were worked out so that basically most of this mountain becomes Open Space for the good of the citizens. NREL continues its laboratory work with the State Patrol it's official track. But otherwise it's in the public domain.
